Free to Succeed

Seventh in the series *Unshackled: Our Freedom in Christ*
Philippians 3:12-4:1

Many people possess the wrong idea of success. As Christians we need to realize that success—true success—comes from our inner life, not our outer. We should model someone who was truly successful in life, who was full of peace and joy no matter the external circumstances. That someone is the Apostle Paul. Let's study his attitude and listen carefully to four keys for successful living.

1. The principle of evaluation
2. The principle of elimination
3. The principle of concentration
4. The principle of determination

If you want to have spiritual success, understand two things: First, you don't have to be perfect. But in Christ you need to evaluate your growth and progress. Second, you can make a commitment today to learn from the past in order to move forward.
